The Role

The Maternal Child Health Program Manager will work directly with LMH's Programs team and County Health Team (identified focal persons) to further establish districts of innovation and excellence in Maternal and child health, thus facilitating a continuum of quality care. This will be done through regular assessments, supportive supervision, quality improvement, and innovation that are done in partnership with CHT/MOH.

What You'll Do

- Codesign and perform facility and district level assessment to identify gaps in quality MCH care and priorities for interventions
- Participate in JISS with CHT
- Engage with CHTs, QAOs, DHOs around QI initiatives and promote ongoing development of district-based quality improvement committees
- Identify and address potential areas for growth in capacity of focal persons including that of reproductive health supervisors, midwives, OICs, DHOs in relation to MCH
- Work with HEAL fellow and CHT to perform root cause analysis on a high morbidity or case of mortality and support quarterly M&M conference
- Attend and Support Maternal, neonatal and child death audits
- Work with CHT to identify potential interventions to support gaps identified in root cause analyses
- Work with CHT and medical director to do design of mentored supervision framework to address gaps in capacity and quality
- Implement MESH alongside Work with QAOs, and quality improvement committees to support ongoing development, completion, and iteration of district-based QI projects around MCH.
- Collect and review data from ongoing QI projects and compile findings for sharing results and lessons in relation to MCH
- Join quarterly Board Quality Committee calls.
- Attend regular programmatic support calls for each county (every 2 weeks) and QRMs when possible
- Attend county level TWGs to include those for maternal child health
- Attend biweekly innovation meetings with programs team at large
- Help review and prepare quality-oriented data for NCHAP quarterly meetings.
- Work with counties to ensure activities tracked in implementation tracker

- Experience with OB ultrasound preferred
- Experience with multidisciplinary education and working in interdisciplinary teams
