### Required Documents

(Note: if you have not yet taken the exam, please provide a written statement describing when you will take it. If you have taken the exam but don't yet have your scores, please let us know.)
- **Grade 10, 11, and 12 transcripts** in PDF format
- **College or university transcripts** in PDF format, if applicable

### Program Eligibility

We're looking for applicants who are:

- Between 17-22 years old
- Passionate about changing Liberia
- Graduating secondary school before January 2020
- Living within 1 hour of Monrovia for SAT prep classes
- From a low-income household
- Interested in pursuing an undergraduate degree at a U.S. college or university (SHE-CAN does not help students seeking graduate degrees).
- Already leaders in their school or community
- Academically strong: Consistently ranked high in your class (1-5) with strong grades and a strong score on the WAEC. This is important because all U.S. universities are challenging and only accept those with the highest grades.

- Dedicated to the program: Able to dedicate your time in January 2020 – June 2020 to complete the pre-college program. You must agree to not work at a full-time job during this period.
- Able to access a strong internet connection and computer daily
