ESSENTIAL DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

- 1. Tasks include fixing minor mechanical problems and liaising with the Maintenance Technician for major mechanical problems
- 2. Facilitate vehicle servicing and repairs as needed
- 3. Performs preventive maintenance activities (e.g., changes oil, replaces filters, lubricates fittings, checks belts, maintains fluid levels, etc.)
- 4. Picks up and delivers equipment, materials, and other supplies as directed.
- 5. Provides transportation for staff, guests, and visitors
- Supports Second Chance Chimpanzee Refuge Liberia (SCCRL) procurement including, but not limited to, loading and unloading supplies, researching suppliers, and picking up materials.
- 7. Maintains vehicle mileage, fuel, and maintenance log records.
- 8. Assists the Maintenance Technician and Senior Manager, Facilities, with the regular servicing and maintenance of all vehicles by external mechanics.
- 9. Assists the Maintenance Technician with onsite repairs and maintenance of vehicles, as needed.
- 10. Performs other duties or responsibilities, as assigned.
