This grant will be used to finance activities of the Smallholder Agriculture Development for Food and Nutrition Security (SADFONS) Project. The project intends to apply part of the proceeds toward the procurement of various Equipment for Agri SMEs/Micro Hubs for the processing of Rice and Cassava.

3. Bidding will be conducted through the Open Competitive Bidding International (OCB-I) method as specified in the Bank's new Procurement Framework which became effective as from the 1st of January 2016 and is open to all eligible bidder as defined in the Procurement Framework.

The method of payment will be in cash or by direct deposit, the banking details will be provided when requested. The document will be sent via email or in hard copy.

6. Electronic Bidding will not be permitted. Late Bids will be rejected. Bids will be publicly opened in the presence of the Bidders designated representatives and anyone who chooses to attend at the address below.
