The Government of the Republic of Liberia has received funding from the African Development Bank Group (AfDB) towards the cost of paving the John Davis Town – Zwedru City (48.5km) under the Mano River Union Road Development and Transport Facilitation Programme (MRU/RDTFP) Phase IV. It intends to use part of the proceeds of the MRU IV funding for payment of the contract for Monitoring and Evaluation Consultancy Services for the construction of an asphaltic concrete road from John Davis Town to Zwedru City (48.5 km).

The service will involve assisting the MPW in carrying out the impact evaluation study for the Project in its entirety. The Consultant will conduct a baseline survey for the MRU/RDTFP Phase IV: Paving of John Davis Town to Zwedru City (48.5km). However, the Result-Based Logical Frameworks for the MRU/RD/TFP IV must be fully considered when evaluating the impact of the Project. The data collected from this study could be used for future projects. The consultant will carry out additional assessment of the status of the existing LogAlto software - Monitoring and Evaluation and Management Information Systems setup under the MRU I to determine their suitability for the MPW's diverse functions following interventions under the Mano River Union Road Development & Transport Facilitation Programme Phase IV, or develop Monitoring and Evaluation software for Phase IV if the existing LogAlto software is ineffective. The existing M&E System (LogAlto) is expected to facilitate the continuation of periodic monitoring and evaluation of activities that would be implemented under the Ministry of Public Works projects and in Phase IV of the MRU Project.

In addition, the services under this Assignment will include studies to:(i) assess the impact of the John Davies Town to Zwedru City (48.5Km) MRU/RD/TFP Phase IV and establish the baseline situation/values for MRU/RDTFP Phase IV for the impact indicators of the project such as: traffic volumes, travel time saved, vehicle operating costs, transport costs, rural access index, awareness of road safety and road accidents, among others; (ii) monitor the indicators during project

implementation (construction period) and (iii) undertake impact assessment (to include road users survey report as annex to the endline report) at the end of the project to evaluate the impact of the project on the intended beneficiaries with reference to the identified baseline indicators.

The Ministry of Public Works now invites eligible consultants (firms) to indicate their interest in providing these services. Interested consultants **must** provide information indicating that they are qualified to perform the services (i) information detailing the company's existence and areas of expertise (ii) list of similar assignments and experience in similar conditions, (iii) list of overall permanent and temporary staff in fields related to the assignment (iv) evidence of past performance (v) any other relevant information. Consultants may constitute joint ventures to enhance their chances of qualification.

Eligibility criteria, establishment of the short-list, and the selection procedure shall be in accordance with the African Development Bank's "***Procurement Policy and Methodology for Bank Group Funded Operations***" (BPM), dated October 2015, using the Quality & Cost Based Selection (QCBS) method, which is available on the Bank's website at <http://www.afdb.org>. The MPW is under no obligation to shortlist any consultant who expresses interest. The assignment is expected to be carried out for a period of forty-eight (48) months.
