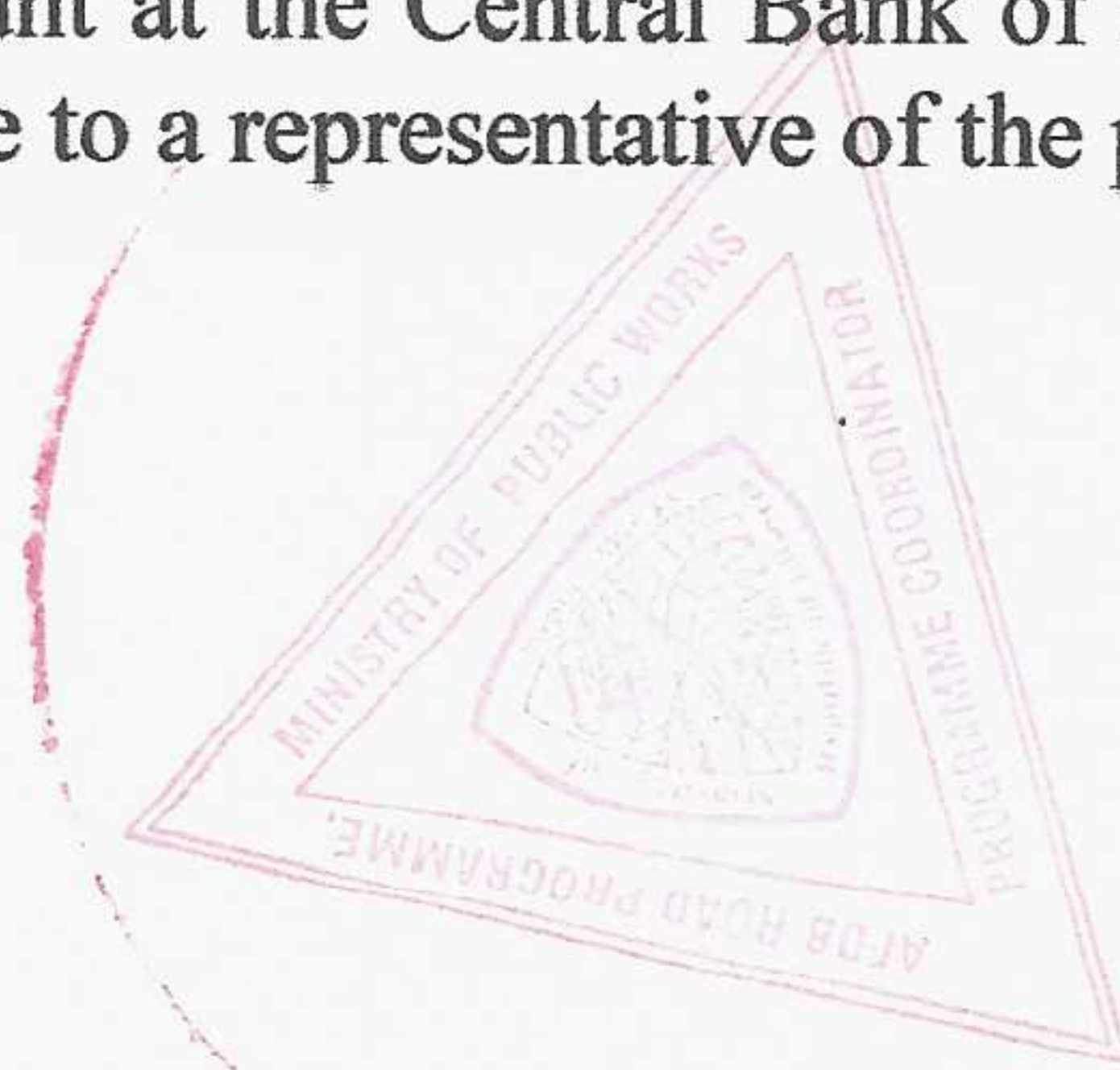
1. The Government of Liberia has received financing from the African Development Bank Group and OPEC Fund for International Development, collectively referred to as the "Bank" toward the cost of the Mano River Union Road Development & Transport

Facilitation Programme (MRU/RDTFP), and intends to apply part of the proceeds toward payments under the contract for Construction of Road from John Davis Town to Zwedru City (48.5 km) in Grand Gedeh County. “For this contract, the Borrower shall process the payments using the Direct Payment disbursement method, as defined in the Bank’s Disbursement Guidelines and procedures for Investment Project Financing.”

2. The Ministry of Public Works now invites sealed bids from eligible bidders for the civil works construction of the road from Davis Town to Zwedru City (48.5km) in Grand Gedeh County for a period of forty-eight (48) months, including thirty-six (36) months construction period and twelve (12) months defects liability period. The civil works involve the alignment of horizontal and vertical curves, earthworks-sub-base course, backfill for drainage structures, and construction of embankments, base course-stabilized and/or crushed stones, binding course and finishing (riding) courses, and the construction of the reinforced concrete bridges.
3. Bidding will be conducted through the Open Competitive Bidding (International), OCBI procedures as specified in the Bank’s [Procurement Framework](#) “Procurement Policy and Methodology for Bank Group Funded Operations” (BPM), dated October 2015” (available on www.afdb.org) and is open to all eligible bidders as defined in the Procurement Framework.

Payment will be made by cash deposit into the Consolidated Account at the Central Bank of Liberia. The tender document will be sent by email or USB drive to a representative of the purchaser.

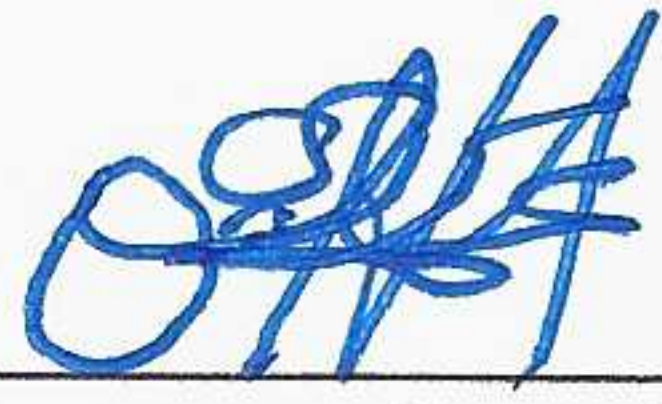
